- International Camellia Gardens of Excellence (GOE): after the evaluation visits done in 2024, I am pleased to announce new and renewed GOES, namely Il Bosco di Camellie (Italy), Antony Woodland Garden (UK), Arboretum Prov. Domein Het Leen (Belgium), Burden Botanic Garden (USA), Exbury Gardens (UK), Foshan Botanical Garden (China), Marwood Hill Gardens (UK), Mount Edgcumbe Country Parc (UK), Nanning Golden Camellia Parc (China), Parque da Pena (Portugal), Pazo de Rubianes (Spain), Parque Terra Nostra (Portugal). - Nuccio's: Nuccio's Nursery survived the devastating Los Angeles fire. Nuccio's, one of the greatest camellia hybridizers, created many world famous cultivars, such as Nuccio's Gem (*C.japonica*), Yuletide (*C.vernalis*), Francie L. (*C.reticulata hybrid*), etc.
- Golden Camellias: Yellow Camellias, about 50 wild species, are seriously endangered; Chinese GOEs (Foshan, Nanning, Jinhua) preserve a set of species, but many endemic species are exposed to predation and extinction in Vietnam. I believe that ICS should promote the creation of a GOE for golden camellias in Vietnam.
