Ishikawa prefecture was severely damaged by the Noto earthquake occurred on Jan. 1st, 2024. By our experience of the Great East Japan Earthquake in 2011 and Kumamoto earth quake in 2016, it takes a long time to recover, for example, the Higo camellia and Higo sasanqua gardens in the Kumamoto Castle shall be closed for 30 years. So, we had been anxious about the precongress tour. We (three core members) visited Ishikawa and Toyama in February and found that the places to visit were not so bad. The local staffs there said that they will be very happy if they have the guests of the International Camellia Congress as a symbol of recovery. We can support them by visiting there as the pre-congress tour of the ICS in 2025.
